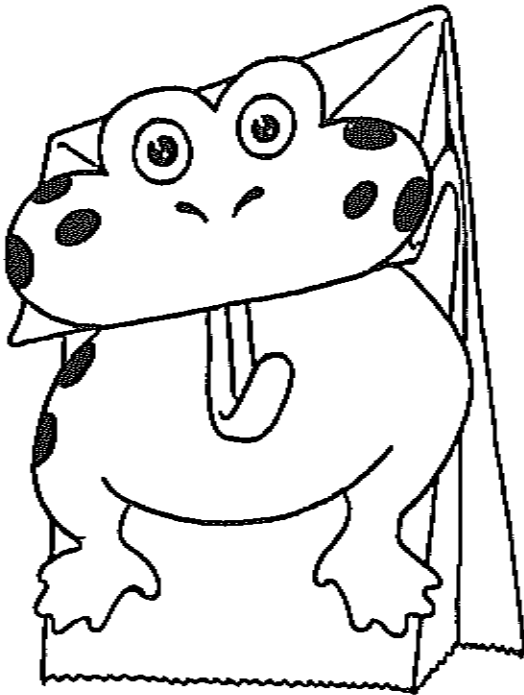


Frog Crafts

FROG PAPER BAG PUPPET

Materials: size 9 paper bag, green and pink construction paper, frog pattern, black felt marker, glue

Directions: Cut the frog head and body from green paper and the tongue from pink paper. Using the felt marker, draw on the eyes, nose, and spots. Glue the head onto the bottom of the sack—the folded section. Glue the body to the sack below the head. Open the folded part of the sack that is now the frog's mouth and glue on the tongue. Insert your hand into the sack and move the mouth up and down to make the puppet talk.



BALLOON FROG

Materials: 10 inch round green balloon, green construction paper, glue, black felt marker, pattern for frog parts

Directions: Inflate and tie balloon. Cut legs from green paper. Glue the frog parts onto the balloon (body) to resemble a frog. Use the felt marker to draw a wide mouth.

Tie a string to the balloon frog and bounce it around to use as the dancing frog in *THE STORY OF THE DANCING FROG* by Quentin Blake. You can also use the frog as the disobedient baby that floats away in *NEVER SNAP AT A BUBBLE* by Yvonne Winer.
